ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

- 1. Applicant must identify as female.
- 2. All material must be original to the applicant.
- 3. The applicant must own the rights to their own material.
- 4. Applicant must live in the Waterloo Region.
- 5. Must organize any accompaniment required for the project.

PRIORITIES

Preference will be given to female identifying artists who also identify as BIPOC.
